

Save Spouts, Save \$\$'s





Dear Half-Mast,

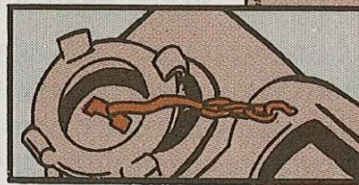
Cap/screen assembly

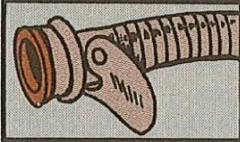

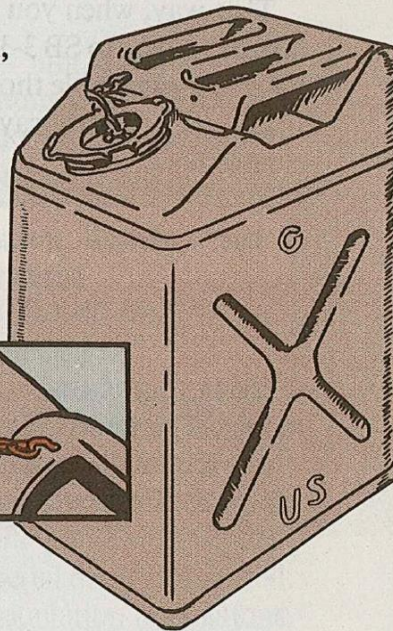
